

## **Pie Baking Contest**

- Will be held Friday, August 3rd. Judging will start at 4:00pm.
- Entries may be submitted beginning at 3pm at the "Baking Contest" tent on Second St.
- Pies must be prepared in a disposable 9"baking tin.
- Pies may not be refrigerated (No meat or dairy products are allowed).
- Please follow all food safety guidelines per the registration form.
- The recipe must accompany each pie along with the name of the contestant.
- Entry requirement is two pies. All entries will become donations to FMCPT/MCSCC
- · Prizes will be awarded immediately after judging
- After the "Official Judging" there will be a "Public Judging". People may judge by their donation toward a specific piece of pie. The pie receiving the highest amount of donations will be returned to the entrant.



## **Cupcake Display and Decorating Contest**

(aka Rib and Jazz Fest Cupcakes Wars)

- Will be held Saturday, August 4th. Judging will start at Noon.
- Entries may be submitted beginning at 11am at the "Baking Contest" tent on Second St.
- Entries will be judged on visual presentation only.
  How well the display follows the theme. Display must fit within a 2' x 2' space.
- The theme of the cupcake contest is "Rib and Jazz".
- All decorations/art items must be edible (no plastic items, beads etc).
- No pre-purchased cupcakes
- Entrants will be judged according to age:

15 and under

16 and over

- Entrance requirement is one dozen cupcakes for judging. All entries will become donations to FMCPT/MCSCC.
- Please follow all food safety guidelines per the registration form.
- Prizes will be awarded immediately after judging.
