- The recipe must accompany each pie along with the name and phone number of the contestant.
- Entry requirement is two pies. All entries will become donations to FMCPT/MCSCC
- Prizes will be awarded immediately after judging
- After the "Official Judging" the pies will be offered to the public "bake sale" style and any proceeds will be split between the two organizations below.

- Will be held Saturday, August 3rd.
- Entries may be submitted 11am—Noon at the City Council Chambers, 6 E. 2nd St.
- All decorations/art items must be edible (no plastic items, beads etc).
- No pre-purchased cupcakes.
- Pies may not be refrigerated (No meat or dairy products are allowed).
- The ingredients must accompany each pie along with the name and phone number of the donor.
- Please follow all food safety guidelines per the donation form.
- The bake sale items will be offered to the public for donations, all proceeds will be split between the two organizations below.
